# **Main Decisions**

### **Current SPI Projects**

# **Expansion of Positive Credit Information Sharing**

Stakeholders will encourage the negative information banks prior to undertaking regulatory actions.

# **Electronic Processing of Debit Instruments**

Plan conceived by Transfond to be endorsed by RBA Board and NBR.

#### **Amendment of AML Law**

Contributions from NBR and AML Office are needed before a law amendment proposal can be prepared.

## **Rural Lending**

RBA will strengthen the operational profile of the project management team.

# **Roland Berger Study**

Additional analyses to bring costs of banking services and products down will be undertaken by a dedicated working group (see New SPI Project).

# New SPI Project

A new project on Improving the Banknotes Structure for ATM Use will be undertaken.

### SPI Program Part II

An independent evaluation of SPI set-up will be performed to support the decision of relevant local stakeholders.

# **Expansion of Positive Credit Information Sharing**

An SPI Committee letter will be sent to largest banks that do not share positive information.

## **Electronic Processing of Debit Instruments**

Regulatory design work could be initiated outside NBR, but under close NBR oversight.

#### **Amendment of AML Law**

SPI Secretariat will prepare a document reflecting consensus of all stakeholders.

## **Rural Lending**

A project strategy meeting will be organized by mid-January.

#### **Bank Guarantees**

Project management team has to decide on an action plan with support from the technical anchor.

# Law on Goods Safeguard and Persons Security

The SPI Committee will forward the technical note with common RBA-NBR position to competent authorities.

# **Other SPI Projects**

All SPI Projects should become operational.
